TIP#1 WRITE A GOOD ESSAY

- Demonstrate:
 - Leadership
 - Community service
 - Work experiences
 - Significant interests

- Be authentic;
 show us who you are!
- Create an 'Essay Hook.'
- Tell a story.
- End with a 'BANG.'

TIP #2 TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ask yourself the following questions:
 - O Which teachers do I know well?
 - O Which teachers know me best?
 - What classes did I really excel in?
- Pick a teacher that knows you both inside and outside the classroom.

TIP#3 TO SUBMIT OR NOT-SCORES

Submit high SAT/ACT scores

- can boost your admissions chances
- makes you stand out amongst your peers
- may help increase your merit-based scholarships

Don't submit low SAT/ACT scores

- can decrease your admissions chances
- may put you at a disadvantage for merit-based scholarships

TIP #4 SECOND CHOICE MAJOR

- Major options
- Consider different interests
- Open the door to other possibilities



TIP #5 APPLY EARLY

- Receive your acceptance letter in December.
- Be able to secure your admissions-based scholarships.
- Gain an advantage when applying to our most competitive programs.
