1 Conduct Review Meeting

These meetings are generally for lower level cases where the student does not have an extensive conduct history

## **Administrative Hearing**

Or

These meetings are generally for higher level cases where the student may have an extensive conduct history

## **Conduct Board Hearing**

These meetings are generally for higher level cases in which Suspension or Dismissal are possible outcomes.

Note: If a student fails to participate in any part of the process, a decision may be made without that student's input.

#### **Grounds for Appeal:**

- Due Process violation (as described in the Code of Student Conduct)
- Information not available at the time of the Conduct Meeting is now available
